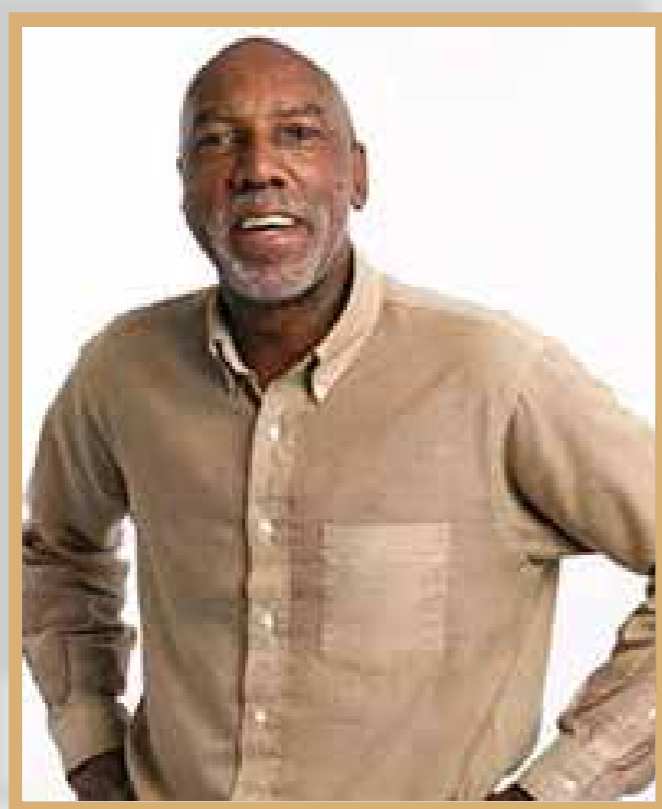

Supervisor for Youth Activities

- Organized and developed youth programs and activities for Elementary – Junior High School for all segments of the community. Programs and activities included; afterschool enrichment programs for elementary age youth, afterschool junior high sports programming for teens, youth sports programs for elementary age youth, Club sports for junior high school students, summer camps and clinics for elementary and junior high school students and community special events activities.
